DESCRIPTION

Green Cush's origins are disputed -- originally bred in Athens, GA in the 1970s, it is descended from the ever-popular Skunk #1, but it **may** also have some Afghani in its background. It delivers a trippy and energetic high that's perfect for daytime use. Its potency ensures that you'll feel uplifted for hours to come. This visual appeal is matched by a dynamic scent. Cured properly, the flowers have a bright citrus scent with mellow undertones of earthiness and wood. The smoke is very smooth, and leaves a tang at the top of the palate and the back of the tongue, reminiscent of mango. On the exhale, smoke tastes vaguely hashy and spicy.

This true breeding strain is a cross consisting of Afghani, Mexican Acapulco Gold and Colombian Gold genetics. It was the first stabilized marijuana hybrid in the Dutch cannabis world and has been bred since 1978. This branch of the cannabis tree has become notorious due to its potency and now the term "skunk" is used to refer to any very potent or powerful cannabis.
